Cremation Choices



You and your family have decided on cremation. Now you need to choose the type of cremation service most appropriate for your family. This booklet, a supplement to our General Price List, is designed to present and explain your options so you can make choices that are right for your family. All of Trimble's Cremation Services include our exclusive Worry-Free Cremation Care™ at no additional cost. Please see the back page for complete details.

Things to Consider

THE VIEWING OF THE BODY

Families may choose to have a ceremony or visitation with the body of the deceased present and viewed followed by cremation, or to have cremation performed first with a ceremony or gathering following. Note that if a responsible family member is not present when one of our Licensed Funeral Directors assumes custody of the deceased at the place of death, and if a service without viewing is selected, we require a personal identification in the Reflection Room in our Care Center prior to cremation.

THE CELEBRATION OF LIFE CEREMONY

Choices for the Celebration of Life Ceremony include a **Funeral Service** with the embalmed body present, or a **Memorial Service** without the body present.

THE VISITATION OR GATHERING

Choices for the visitation or gathering include a **Visitation**, which is a time for family and friends to gather with the body present, or a **Gathering**, which typically is held without the body present. A **Public Visitation or Gathering** of family and friends can be held the day before the ceremony, the day of the ceremony, or in place of the ceremony, while a **Private Visitation or Gathering** includes only the family and those they invite. A **Hospitality Gathering** adds favorite foods and beverages for the family and guests.

WITNESSING THE CREMATION AND CREMATORY INSPECTION

If you wish, you are welcome to view our crematory room for a pre-cremation inspection. You will have the opportunity to see that the cremation chamber is clean and empty and, if desired, to witness the cremation casket or container enter the cremation chamber. The option to witness the cremation is available at no charge with all Cremation Services and Plans, except Simple Cremation Online.

Caskets, Containers, and Urns

A casket is not required for cremation unless there is a public viewing of the body, in which case a cremation casket is necessary. If a casket is not chosen, Illinois law requires that the bodies of deceased individuals being cremated be enclosed in an "alternative container", defined as a rigid, leak-proof, combustible container for the cremation process.

Simple Cremation

Simple Cremation provides for the dignified disposition of the body without any funeral or memorial ceremonies or public visitation or gathering. A casket is not required for a Simple Cremation, but a cremation container must be selected (see page 3). A memorial service or hospitality gathering can follow a Simple Cremation.

Simple Cremation, including crematory charge, 3090

Offering more than other funeral firms do with their "direct cremation", our Simple Cremation includes our exclusive "Worry-Free Cremation Care"[™], and sanitary care and dressing of the deceased. This allows for immediate adult family members to have a private time to say good-bye in our Reflection Room prior to cremation at no charge. Our licensed funeral directors will transfer the deceased from a local hospital or nursing home into our care^(*). We will provide shelter in our on-site climate-controlled facility while we secure all authorizations and permits, and our Cremation Specialists will perform the cremation in our on-site crematory. Included at no additional charge is an identification viewing (required by us if the responsible party is not present when we take custody of the deceased), cremation witnessing by immediate family if desired, and a temporary urn. In addition, we will prepare and submit the obituary to local newspapers, publish the obituary on our internet media-site, and coordinate with clergy, cemeteries, florists, and others who may be involved. A cremation container must be selected (see page 3). ^(*)If death occurs in a residence or other non-institution location, an additional charge of 140 will apply.

Simple Cremation with a Memorial Service, 3650

Simple Cremation with a Memorial Service adds a memorial service, up to one hour, in our facility or your church following the cremation, with a staff member in attendance to coordinate details .

Simple Cremation with a Hospitality Gathering, 4220

Simple Cremation with Hospitality Gathering adds a hospitality gathering in CityView Celebrations at Trimble Pointe, our reception center. This includes hors d'oeuvres or snacks and non-alcoholic beverages for 40 to 80 people for two hours. Alcoholic beverages and expanded food items are available at an additional cost by consulting with our event coordinator.

Simple Cremation Online, including crematory charge, 2445

Only available online — not available at any location and no in-person consultation. Simple Cremation Online includes only limited professional services with basic cremation in our onsite crematory, and is available in Rock Island, Henry, and Mercer Counties in Illinois, and Scott and Muscatine Counties in Iowa, with no additional mileage charges. To take advantage of this package, all authorizations and documents must be completed online and payment must be made in full at that time. Our licensed staff is available for consultation by telephone, but in-person consultation is not included, nor is any viewing. Worry-Free Cremation Care™

Trimble's Worry-Free Cremation Care™ begins as one of our Licensed Funeral Directors assumes custody of the deceased. If the death has occurred in a health care facility, all identification bands are checked and identity is confirmed with nursing personnel. Should death occur at home or other location, the identity is confirmed with the next-of-kin, responsible family member, coroner or other authority.

Unless circumstances dictate otherwise, we require a personal identification by the next-of-kin, or his or her representative. This can be done at the time we assume custody of the body or in the Reflection Room in the comfort of our Care Center.

A **non-combustible identification tag** is placed on the deceased, and information is logged into our record system. This tag stays on the deceased through the cremation process and is then placed with the cremated remains in the urn.

The deceased is transferred to our on-site climate-controlled secure Care Center for shelterization while we obtain authorizations and permits, and the cremation casket or cremation container selected by the family is clearly labeled for identification.

By Illinois law, cremation cannot take place until 24 hours after death, nor before the next-of-kin, attending physician, coroner or medical examiner, and registrar have all given their respective certifications or authorizations. This can sometimes take three or four days, especially over a weekend.

One of our Licensed Funeral Directors reviews the cremation documents to insure that all required authorizations and permits have been received, and schedules the cremation with our Crematory. All cremations are performed in our private, interior, on-site crematory, so the deceased never leaves our care.

One of our Cremation Specialists (all of whom are Certified Cremation Operators) assists in placing the cremation casket or container into the cremation chamber and begins the cremation process.

If you wish, you are welcome to view our crematory for a pre-cremation inspection where you will have the opportunity to see that the cremation chamber is clean and empty. If desired, immediate family members may witness the cremation casket or container enter the cremation chamber. A Crematory Specialist will be available to answer any questions you may have.

Following cremation and processing, the cremated remains along with the identification tag are sealed in the permanent urn the family has chosen, or placed in a clearly labeled temporary plastic urn. The urn is ready for committal services, if any, or it may be picked up by the family, or delivered or mailed by us as instructed.
